

2016 Greater Lansing Homeless Resolution Network Committee Report



Membership Committee

Role: To grow the CoC and assist member agencies
Accomplishments: Increased member agencies by 15%, held training sessions for members, and increased outreach to community groups
2017 Goals: Expand the committee and GLHRN, hold more training sessions

Finance Committee

Role: To oversee GLHRN Finances
Accomplishments: Improved grant review process, oversaw three successful grant funding cycles
2017 Possible Goals: Fine-tune grant process, develop spend-down monitoring process, help GLHRN become revenue neutral

HARA Committee

Role: To oversee and support the HARA
Accomplishments: Committee was created, established clearer HARA policies and procedures
2017 Goals: Create an effective policy on chronically homeless verification, work toward coordination of intake

CQI Committee

Role: To monitor data quality and CoC outcomes
Accomplishments: Upheld high standards of data quality, established GLHRN grievance policy, improved chronically homeless verification process
2017 Goals: Monitor CoC data effectively, examine outcome targets to determine effectiveness

Human Services Committee

Role: To assist staff on the frontlines
Accomplishments: Traveled to CRM, CAMW, CMH, Wellness INX, TCOA, and LAAN to learn about their programs/increase coordination; updated the discharge plan
2017 Goals: Improve CoC performance via enhanced coordination, learn about lesser known programs

Veteran Services Committee

Role: To streamline the housing of homeless veterans
Accomplishments: Created a working By Name List of all homeless veterans in Ingham, met criteria of housing \leq the number of homeless veterans identified
2017 Goals: Declare Functional Zero for homeless veterans, continue to streamline the veteran housing process
