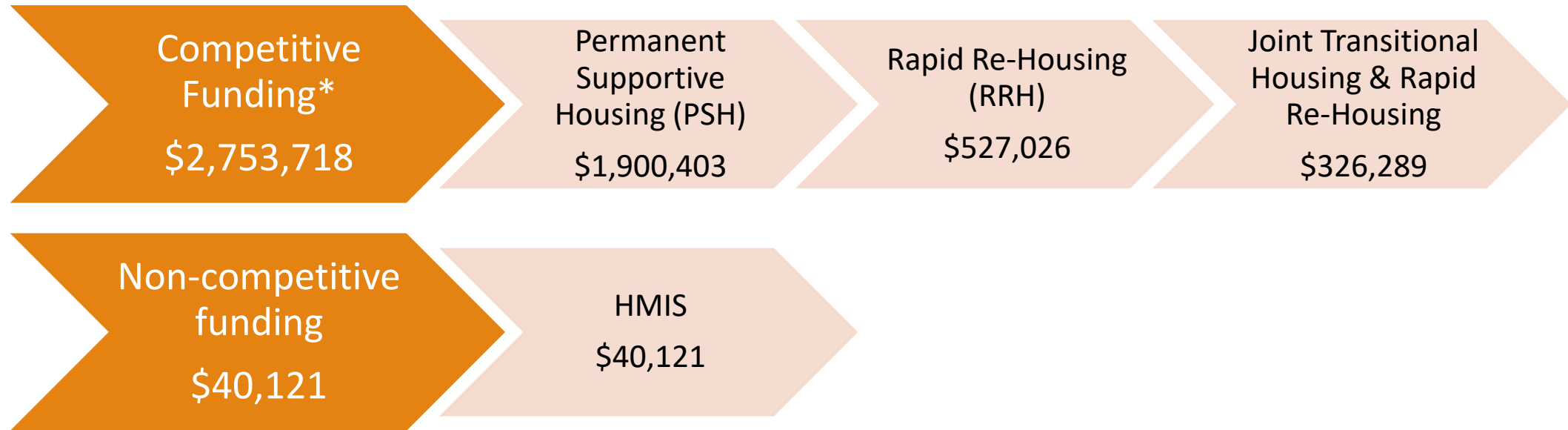

Bonus Funding Opportunities

For new projects or to expand existing projects

Bonus – Up to \$139,692

- Permanent Supportive Housing
- Rapid Re-Housing
- Joint Transitional Housing and Rapid Re-housing
- Supportive Services Only – Coordinated Entry

Domestic Violence (DV) Bonus – Up to \$329,469; (minimum of \$50,000)

- Rapid Re-Housing
- Joint Transitional Housing and Rapid Re-housing
- Supportive Services Only – Coordinated Entry specifically to better meet the needs of survivors experiencing homelessness

Changes/Revisions from Previous NOFO's

- Renewals vs. new projects (bonus or reallocations);
- Tribes and TDHEs are eligible to apply for projects in 2021.
- Housing First model prioritizes rapid placement in permanent housing; no preconditions (defined, pg 23).
- Incentives for new projects incorporating healthcare organizations;
- Collaboration with PHAs
- Racial equity – the application will have questions on this issue;

Changes/Revisions from Previous NOFO's

- Involvement of current/former persons with lived experience homeless;
- Address how our CoC/your agency addressed COVID related to homelessness;
- HUD Policy Priorities – priorities for services, Housing First, unsheltered, system performance measures
- Program Implementation – expansion, transition grants, consolidation projects
- DV Bonus projects – types of configurations
